

An Appeal to the God of Heaven
Prayer Guide from the Book of Esther

1. Stir your people to care and know what is happening, not only on earth, but moreso, on the higher level – in the 2nd heaven, where principalities and powers rule, and especially in the 3rd heaven, where Jesus sits at the right hand of the Majesty on High.
2. Give us prophetic Mordecai's – who see clearly and who humble themselves in sackcloth, if need be, and lay their lives down, whatever people think and whatever the risk.
3. Give us prophetic fathers and mothers who alert even the younger generation – the Esther generation -- to the ENEMY'S desire and design. Uncover and reveal the plot of the wicked one.
4. Give us "Esthers" -- key leaders in key positions who are willing to risk their lives for truth.
5. Give strategy for setting the stage for appeal -- to access high-level authority, not only in heaven, but also on earth
6. Bring the righteous to their knees to "appeal to heaven." Call your people to humble themselves, to fast and pray in one accord – both corporately and privately. Raise up Mordecai's to gather your servants together to pray for the "cause." Raise up personal intercessors, like Esther's Maidens, to pray for the 'persons' you will use to intervene.
7. Turn the hearts of leaders on every level to see and hear clearly, to discern rightly, to make right judgments, and be used of God to stay the hand of evil.
8. Reveal the hearts of the wicked and bring them to their knees that they may appeal for mercy. Turn the tide of evil plots and plans and people – but save multitudes from sin and selfishness. Bring many to repentance. Give forgiveness and new life to many.
9. Give authority to legislators who will write the "higher" laws that will turn things around and truly bring "liberty and justice for all."
10. Turn captivity captive! Save, O Lord, save – for thine own Name's sake! Set new historical markers with deliverances of Biblical proportions that we may remember Thy mercy and Thy power to save.
11. Receive our thanks and honor – "for Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever."
