1. Jesus says to Simon Peter,

"Simon of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these?"

("...do you LOVE me : \_\_\_\_\_ *me*?" )

→

He says to Him, "Yes, Lord, (*Nai Kurie*)

You \_\_\_\_\_ (*su oidas*)

that I LOVE ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) you."

←

He says to him,

"Feed (*Boske*) my \_\_\_\_\_ (*arnia*)."

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2. He says to him \_\_\_\_\_ (*palin*) a second time (*deuteron*)

"Simon of Jonas, lovest thou me?"

("...do you LOVE me?" " \_\_\_\_\_ *me*?" )

→

He says to Him, "Yes, Lord, (*Nai Kurie*)

You \_\_\_\_\_ (*su oidas*)

that I LOVE ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) you."

←

He says to him,

" Tend / care for (*Poimaine*) my \_\_\_\_\_ (*probata*)."

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3. He says to him the \_\_\_\_\_ time (*to triton*)

"Simon of Jonas, lovest thou me?"

("...do you LOVE me: \_\_\_\_\_ *me*?" )

or (...do you have \_\_\_\_\_ for me?" )

→

Peter was \_\_\_\_\_ (*elupethe*)

←

because He said to him the \_\_\_\_\_ time (*to triton*)

"Lovest thou me?" (" \_\_\_\_\_ *me*?" )

→

And he said to him, "Lord, (*Kurie*)

"You \_\_\_\_\_ (*su oidas*) all things (*panta*);

You fully \_\_\_\_\_ (*su gignoskeis*)

(*Meaning* \_\_\_\_\_)

that I LOVE ( \_\_\_\_\_ ) You."

←

("...I have \_\_\_\_\_ for and \_\_\_\_\_ to You.")

Jesus says to him,

"Feed my \_\_\_\_\_ (*Boske probata*)."
